Wind Speed: enter code for range; L for Light (felt on face, 0-7 mph), M for Moderate (branch ends in constant motion, 8-12 mph), S for Strong (small trees in constant motion, 13-24 mph), VS for Very Strong (large trees in constant motion, 25+ mph).

Wind From: enter compass direction wind coming from; N, NNE, NE, etc.

Temperature: enter degrees in Celsius.

Cloud Cover: enter percent of sky with background cloud cover.

Visibility: enter code; VH for Very Hazy (see less than 2 miles), H for Hazy (see 2-5 miles), C for Clear (see 6-24 miles), VC for Very Clear (see 25 miles or more).

Flight Direction: Enter compass direction migrants headed toward; N, NNE, NE, etc.

Height of flight overhead: enter code; L for Low (up to 100'), M for Medium (more than 100' but visible to unaided eye), H for High (beyond limit of unaided vision).

Observers: enter number contributing to the count.

Duration of observation: enter in tenths of an hour (.5 = 30 minutes).

Humidity: enter as percentage.

Barometric pressure: enter in inches.
