Wind Speed-Use actual, or codes: **L** - Light(felt on face,0-7mph), **M** - Moderate (branche tips in constant motion,8-12mph) **S** - Strong (small trees in constant motion,13-24mph), **VS** - VeryStrong (large trees in motion,25+mph)

Wind Direction: direction the wind is coming from **Cloud Cover:** percent of sky with cloud cover

Visibility: **VH** - very hazy (<2mi), **H** - hazy (2-5mi), **C** - Clear (6-24mi), **VC** - Very Clear (25+mi)

Flight Direction: Direction **towards** which the migrant hawks are flying. On Hook S is towards NYC

Height of Flight: **L** - Low (<100ft), **M** - medium (>100 & visible naked eye), **H** - High (beyond unaided vision)

No. of Observers: Number of observers contributing to the count **Comments** (here & on back):
