Directions:

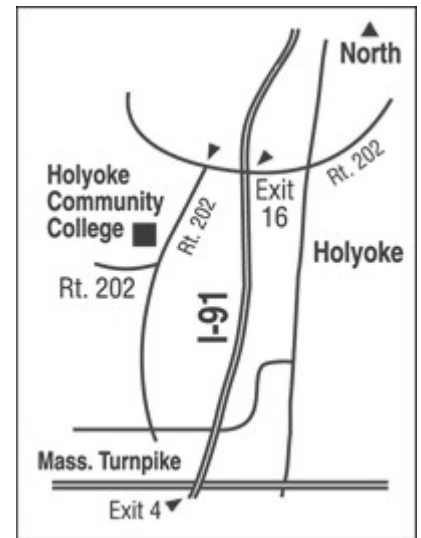
From Mass. Turnpike: Take Exit 4 to I-91 North.
